Year 6 – Isle of Wight Educational Visit 2019

This letter contains details of the proposed Year 6 Educational Visit to the Isle of Wight in July 2017. Enclosed are the details of cost, accommodation, travel arrangements and dates. It is our aim to take every child in Year 6 on the trip, but we are fully aware that a residential is not for everyone, and therefore a full teaching programme will be available at school during the week.

- 1 Location of Visit:** Isle of Wight
- 2 Dates of visit: Monday 8th – Friday 12th July 2019** (5 days/4 nights)
- 3 Purpose of Visit:**
 - To provide the children with a range of first hand experiences to develop their knowledge and understanding in a range of curriculum areas; including English, Geography, History, Science, Technology and Art.
 - To develop the children's social skills and independence.
- 4 Accommodation:**

We will be staying in the Chester Lodge Hotel and the Malvern Hotel, both in Sandown.

- 5 Travel arrangements:** Coach/Ferry. The coaches will remain with us throughout the visit.
- 6 Cost: Total cost per child: £295**

It is our aim to take every child on the residential but we must cover our costs for the trip to go ahead. We always strive to keep the cost of residential trips as low as possible but in order to run this trip it is necessary to request a voluntary contribution from each parent for the full amount of £295 per child. **In order to secure a place on the visit we require a non-refundable deposit of £75 per child.** Please be aware that if there is a significant shortfall the governors of the school reserve the right to cancel the trip.

Financial Arrangements- please pay by Parentmail

The non-refundable £75 deposit is due **by Monday 26th November 2018**. If you pay by parentmail we do not need the form filling in, saving you time. You can pay by cheque or cash but we will need the form, please. All payments must be made **via the class teacher and not the office**.

Option 1: The outstanding balance of £220 can be paid **in full** in the week beginning 28th January

Option 2: The outstanding balance can be paid in **three instalments** as follows:
