Update COVID-19 information

As a school we are continuing to follow the information and guidance given to us through Public Health England and the Department of Education. We are now beginning to operate a scaled back version of 'business as usual'. Based on the concept of social distancing, essential activities rather than desirable activities will continue to take place.

- Year three swimming is now cancelled.
- All inter- school sports have been cancelled.
- G-live music rehearsals and evening concert have been cancelled.
- All external volunteers and visitors to the school have been postponed or cancelled until further notice.
- We will not be having assemblies to avoid larger gathering.
- Children who eat packed lunches will eat in classrooms or outside according to the weather.

Today all children will bring home a pack of schoolwork showing which tasks should be completed. This should be kept somewhere safe at home, in the event of school closure and the pack is needed. If you do not receive a pack, please let us know. Packs will be posted to families who are currently not at school.

Currently we are continuing to run lessons as usual until we are told otherwise by Public Health England or until such time as we are unable to staff the safe running of the school.

I will continue to update you as information becomes available.
