
- Red or black in colour

ACCESS TO SCHOOL BUILDINGS

In line with current COVID guidelines, to minimize the spread of the virus, we are requesting parents and visitors do not enter the school building to break the school and class bubbles.

- If you need to collect your child during the day, or are called to collect them, please wait under the outside classroom and a member of staff will walk the child out to meet you.
- At this time, we do not have the capacity for visitors or parents to use our toilets facilities, as this would result in us breaking a class / staff bubble. We would be required to clean the toilet facility before and after visitors or parents had used the facilities. In emergencies if a younger sibling should be desperate, when collection siblings from Northmead at the end of the day we would ask you to contact the school office.
