PENALTY NOTICES

We would like to remind parents that if there is an unauthorized leave of absence for 5 or more school days, each parent/carer will be liable to receive a penalty notice.

Penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child and the amount payable is £60.00 if paid within 21 days, rising to £120.00 if paid after 21 days but before 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court.
