The first two days before the children returned were used for valuable staff training. Tuesday 3rd January was a trust INSET day. We joined colleagues from other schools in our Learning Partners Trust to listen to keynote speaker Peps Mccrea talk about strategies to improve memory and how to support children retain what they have learned. Staff were also able to attend workshop sessions. Wednesday 4th January's training session was held at our own school led by Sarah Stocking, SENDCo and Head of Centre. The session explored the fact that as a compassionate school staff need knowledge about autism, sensory difficulties, PDA, ADHD, attachment and trauma impact. This interesting and valuable training was a worthwhile refresher for many staff and a useful induction for new staff.
