Dear Parents,

**Winter Production 2025 "Pirates of the Curry Bean!" – School Hall  
Monday 8<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 6:30pm**

I am writing to update you about arrangements for the school production.  
There are several important points I need to make and I will endeavour to do so as clearly as I can.

### **Buying Tickets**

Each ticket is £6.50. Due to health and safety requirements, we have a limit of people we are able to seat in the hall. Due to this safety rule and as with previous years, we are implementing a **2 ticket per family rule**. This means that we will only allocate **2 tickets, in total, to each family**. For example; a family with one child in year 3 and one in year 5 would initially be allocated 2 tickets to purchase. We operate a waiting list and hope to accommodate all extra needs so please contact the office if you wish to make use of this. We realise that only having two tickets can cause difficulties for split families, but health and safety does not allow us to release any more tickets.

**One ticket = One seat = One Adult or Child over the age of 5**  
**The production is not suitable for under 5's. Children will not be allowed to sit on their parent's lap.**

If you have a disability please contact the office so that we can make suitable adjustments.

Tickets can be purchased through MCAS. It is important to ensure that you order for the correct cast and performance date. Due to high demand for tickets, we **CANNOT** guarantee that requests to change dates would be accommodated so it is **imperative that you buy the correct tickets for the correct night** - Cast A performance is Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Dec and 9<sup>th</sup> Dec. Cast B performance is Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> Dec and Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> Dec. As tickets are allocated on a first come first served basis, please order tickets as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. Tickets will be available this week, an email notification will let you know when they are released for sale. When buying your tickets it is essential that you only buy 2 at a maximum. **Anyone who buys more than 2 tickets as described will not be refunded and your surplus tickets cannot be issued.**

This year you will not be issued a paper ticket. We will sign people in to the hall on the evening of the event.  
There will be **NO** cash tickets on the night.

Please be aware that the performance includes a large number of flashing lights and loud music/bangs.

### **Arrival and collection of children.**

All children in Yr. 3,4 and 5 need to enter through the red fire doors in the walking zone where a member of staff will receive them and direct them to their class bases.  
Yr 6 can enter the school via the front door and make their way to the year 6 classrooms where they will be registered.  
For the safety of the children we are asking that the door nearest the library is not used.
